Accessing SPP Online Portal As the Plan Administrator for the CGI Share Purchase Plan, Computershare will set up an account in your name and hold your shares.

To access your account, go to http://www.computershare.com/employee/cgispp

You will then be directed to the CGI login page.



You now have 2 choices.

- a.) **Existing User** Select "Login" if you have previously accessed your account online.
- b.) New User Select "Activate Account" if you are a new user and have not yet accessed your account online. You may activate your account now using your initial credentials and create your personalized User ID and Password. Your initial credentials can be located on the Welcome and PIN letters you have received.
